SENATE BILL NO. 3146

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the
expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority for the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
\$ 19,061,458.00.
SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Development Authority or
the appropriate special fund for the purpose of defraying the
expenses incurred in the operation of the various divisions of the
authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
June 30, 2003\$ 145,229,981.00.
SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
expenditure:

- 65 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal
- 66 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with
- 67 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce
- 68 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement
- 69 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as
- 70 the requirements of this provision are met.
- 71 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 72 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- 73 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 74 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 75 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 76 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 77 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
- 78 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall
- 79 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray
- 80 the expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority in operating
- 81 the state welcome centers.
- 82 **SECTION 5.** The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and
- 83 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or
- 84 other orders of or agreements involving any agency,
- 85 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United
- 86 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may
- 87 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the
- 88 Mississippi Development Authority or any programs sponsored under
- 89 the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not
- 90 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and approved,
- 91 provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise
- 92 accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq., and
- 93 Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 94 SECTION 6. Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to 95 escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 96 Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 97 98 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 99 100 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 101 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete 102 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 103 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 104 105 Year 2002. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2004 shall be 106 107 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 108 109 provided during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request process. SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 110 111 the amount of Four Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars (\$4,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 112 113 provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2003. The expenditure 114 115 of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972. 116 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 117 118 the amount of One Million Sixty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,067,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 119 120 provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2003. 121 The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be 122 123 exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 10. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 124

Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of

the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized

165	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
166	Executive Director of the Mississippi Development Authority may
167	authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in total
168	amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the
169	appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided
170	that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a
171	corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be
172	authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
173	"Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."
174	SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein
175	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
176	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
177	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
178	Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for the
179	Institute for Technology Development, for the fiscal year
180	beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
181	\$ 500,000.00.
182	The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section
183	are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for
184	support of the Institute for Technology Development to equip,
185	operate and maintain a post-graduate, integrated circuit design,
186	engineering training program, known as ComPEET. The funds herein
187	appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds
188	appropriated to the Mississippi Development Authority.
189	SECTION 13. In addition to all other sums herein
190	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
191	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
192	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
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193	Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for
194	Mississippi Technology Alliance, for the fiscal year beginning
195	July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
196	\$ 850,000.00.
197	The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section
198	are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for
199	support of Mississippi Technology Alliance to strengthen the
200	business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and
201	growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more
202	high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi
203	economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
204	apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi
205	Development Authority.
206	SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein
207	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
208	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
209	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
210	Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds to
211	support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce
212	Initiative, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
213	June 30, 2003\$ 1,250,000.00.
214	The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
215	apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi
216	Development Authority.
217	SECTION 15. In addition to all other sums herein
218	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
219	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special source funds
220	not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing funds to
221	support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce Initiative, for
222	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
223	\$ 4,000,000.00.
224	SECTION 16. None of the funds appropriated in Section 2
225	shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of

226	Representatives and Mississippi Senate representing such districts
227	are notified at least three (3) days prior to the awarding of
228	Community Development Block Grants or any other grants to their
229	districts.
230	SECTION 17. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
231	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
232	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
233	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
234	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
235	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
236	SECTION 18. This act shall take effect and be in force from
237	and after July 1, 2002.
