AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF 1 ANIMAL HEALTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Board of Animal Health 8 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending 9 June 30, 2003..... \$ 1,238,853.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 12 13 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Board 14 of Animal Health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and 15 16 ending June 30, 2003..... \$ 223,625.00. SECTION 3. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 46 47 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 48 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 49 50 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 51 52 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 53 54 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 55 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 56 57 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 58 59 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 60

"Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 61 62 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 63 64 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 65 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 66 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 67 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 68 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 69 the requirements of this provision are met. 70

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 77 78 Executive Director of the Mississippi Board of Animal Health may authorize increases in other objects of expenditure in total 79 amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 80 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 81 82 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be 83 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 84 85 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 86 SECTION 5. 87 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 88 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 89 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 90 91 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 92 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002. 93
