It shall be the responsibility of the 51 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 52 53 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 54 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 55 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 56 57 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 58 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 59 60 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 61

- 62 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
