4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service for
9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
LO	\$ 19,117,521.00
L1	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L2	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
L3	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
L4	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
L5	Cooperative Extension Service for the fiscal year beginning
L6	July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003 \$ 15,699,021.00
L7	SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended hereir
L8	shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds
L9	which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions
20	of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
21	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
22	Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service provide programs in the
23	emphasis areas of Agriculture, Home Economics, 4-H, and Community
24	Resource Development in each county.
25	SECTION 5. No part of the funds appropriated or authorized
26	to be expended hereby shall be spent directly or indirectly for

payment of attorneys' fees for the services of any attorney who

28 was not employed by the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service

29 pursuant to the express authorization of the Board of Trustees of

30 Institutions of Higher Learning prior to performance of such legal

- 32 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 33 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2004 shall be submitted to
- 34 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 35 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 36 during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request process.
- 37 **SECTION 7.** It is the intent of the Legislature that if the
- 38 funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly or
- 39 indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants,
- 40 research grants or donations, such special source funds not
- 41 classified as current restricted funds shall be added and
- 42 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the
- 43 intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special
- 44 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2001
- 45 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature.
- 46 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
- 47 Million Two Hundred Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-six
- 48 Dollars (\$1,222,596.00) shall be derived from the Education
- 49 Enhancement Fund from funds deposited pursuant to Sections
- 50 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 51 **SECTION 9.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 52 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 53 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 54 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
- 55 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
- 56 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

83	SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by	
84	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the	
85	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon	
86	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal	
87	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the	
88	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.	
89	SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from	
90	and after July 1, 2002.
