4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the general expenses of the operation of the Mississippi
9	National Guard for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and
10	ending June 30, 2003\$ 4,752,666.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Mississippi National
13	Guard, out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the
14	Camp Shelby Timber FundNo. 3700, as created by Chapter 187, Laws
15	of 1954, as amended; the Service Contract FundNo. 3701; the Camp
16	Shelby Base Operations FundNo. 3705; the Air National Guard
17	Training Site Base Operations FundNo. 3709; and the Education
18	Enhancement Fund, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions
19	of applicable statutes and federal/state agreements for the fiscal
20	year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
21	\$ 51,273,285.00.
22	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
23	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
24	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

46	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
47	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
48	equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the
49	Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00),
50	whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.
51	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
52	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
53	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
54	Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003
55	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or
56	pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi
57	Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget
58	Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish
59	separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data,
60	for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and
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- January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 61 62 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 63 64 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 65 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 66 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 67 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 68 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 69 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 70 71 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 72 73 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 76 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 77

the requirements of this provision are met.

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- 78 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 79 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 80 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 81
- 82 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2004 shall be submitted to 83 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 84 85 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request process. 86
- SECTION 5. All funds authorized to be expended herein shall 87 be expended and otherwise accounted for in accordance with the 88 provisions of Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 89 If not needed for other purposes, the Adjutant General is hereby 90 expressly authorized to invest any part of or all monies herein 91 92 appropriated out of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund at the highest rate of interest obtainable and credit interest accruing on such 93

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investments to the respective fund. Such monies may be invested 94 95 in any short-term bonds, notes or other direct obligations of the United States of America or the State of Mississippi or any county 96 97 or municipality of this state, which said county or municipal 98 bonds have been approved by a reputable bonds attorney or have 99 been validated by a decree of the court, and in any event the said bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are invested shall 100 mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds so invested 101 will be needed for the refund or refunds herein provided for. 102 SECTION 6. The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds 103 104 which may become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi National Guard is hereby authorized 105 106 and approved, provided such expenditures are reported and 107 otherwise handled in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 108 The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds 109 SECTION 7. which may become available to the Mississippi National Guard for 110 111 construction purposes is hereby authorized and approved, provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise handled 112 113 in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 114 115 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds are included in the amount appropriated to the State Department of 116 Education to be transferred to the Mississippi National Guard for 117 118 the support of the Youth Challenge Program at Camp Shelby. SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 119

120 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 121 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 122 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 123 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 124

125 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002. 126
