| 12 | SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be | |

| 16 | become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the | |

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Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 128 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 129 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 130 131 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 132 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 133 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 134 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 135 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 136 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 137 138 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 139 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 140 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 141 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 142 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 143 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 144 145 the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Department of Corrections may use any federal funds that may become available for the construction of a certified fail-safe lethal/non-lethal fencing system at any of its maximum security units for that purpose.

section 5. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,

and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, it is the intention

of the Legislature that any contractual service payments made by

the department to defray medical expenses for inmates shall be at

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- 161 the currently established Medicaid reimbursement rate; however, if
- 162 hospital and medical providers will not contract at the Medicaid
- 163 reimbursement rate, the Department of Corrections may enter into a
- 164 negotiated contract.
- 165 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
- 166 none shall be expended for personnel housing under the
- 167 jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections unless the
- 168 department shall collect a reasonable rent, after a finding of
- 169 fact as to what is a reasonable rent, and/or the cost of utilities
- 170 furnished to said housing, except that the Superintendent of the
- 171 Central Mississippi Correctional Facility may be provided with a
- 172 housing expense allowance in lieu of being furnished with a
- 173 dwelling house. The Department of Corrections shall not pay for
- 174 the installation or monthly service of any telephone installed in
- 175 a staff residence under its jurisdiction.
- 176 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
- 177 and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, payment may be
- 178 authorized for court ordered attorney fees and any accrued
- 179 interest subject to the approval of the Office of the Attorney
- 180 General.
- 181 **SECTION 8.** No part of the funds herein appropriated shall be
- 182 used for the purpose of returning escaped state convicts to the
- 183 State Penitentiary from a distance of over one hundred (100) miles
- 184 beyond the borders of the state, except upon approval of the
- 185 Governor in each specific case.
- 186 **SECTION 9.** None of the money herein appropriated shall be
- 187 paid to any person who by the provision of Section 47-5-47,
- 188 Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, is prohibited from being an
- 189 employee of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. The State
- 190 Department of Finance and Administration shall at least annually
- 191 make a report to the Joint Legislative Committee on Performance
- 192 Evaluation and Expenditure Review and to the Attorney General
- 193 stating the name of any person prohibited under the provisions of

Section 47-5-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, from being 194 195 an employee of the Mississippi Department of Corrections who has 196 during the preceding year received any money herein appropriated. 197 In the event that any such person prohibited as herein above 198 provided from receiving funds herein appropriated should receive 199 any of said funds, the Attorney General shall immediately commence action to recover the monies so paid to said person and to enjoin 200 the further employment of said person at the Mississippi 201 202 Department of Corrections. SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 203 204 Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of Corrections may transfer between the divisions of Support, Medical Services, 205 206 Parole Board, Farming Operations, Private Prisons, Regional 207 Facilities and Local Confinement, both funds and positions not to

exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the authorized budgets in the 208 aggregate. The Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of 209 Corrections shall submit written justification for the transfer to 210 211 the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month prior to 212 213 the effective date of the transfer. It is further the intention of the Legislature that no transfer may be made under the 214 215 provisions of this section to increase or decrease the salaries category of any budget set forth in the original appropriations 216 made under this act, but may be used to contract with counties to 217 218 house state inmates in facilities authorized by Section 47-5-931, Mississippi Code of 1972. It is further the intention of the 219 220 Legislature that any transfers made under the provisions of this paragraph shall be for the removal of state inmates from county 221 jails or of an emergency nature. 222

223 **SECTION 11.** It is the intent of the Legislature that all prisoners at Parchman shall work a minimum of eight (8) hours per day, excluding prisoners with a physical disability or those incarcerated in maximum security.
