1 2	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
7	defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs
8	Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
9	June 30, 2003\$ 2,429,586.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
12	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs
13	Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or
14	otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance
15	of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and
16	ending June 30, 2003\$ 22,332,671.00.
17	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
18	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Health
19	Care Expendable Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose
20	of defraying the expenses of the Veterans' Affairs Board for the
21	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30,
22	2003\$ 700,000.00.
23	SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
24	Sections 1, 2 and 3, not more than the amounts set forth below
25	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
26	expenditure:

47	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
48	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
49	equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the
50	Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00),
51	whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.
52	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
53	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
54	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
55	Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003
56	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or
57	pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi
58	Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget
59	Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish
60	separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, S. B. No. 3166

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for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and 61 January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 62 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 63 64 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 65 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 66 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in 67 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 68 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 69 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 70 71 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 72 73 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 74 75 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 76

77 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 78 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 83 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds in 84 85 the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to 86 87 indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the non-veteran surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the surviving spouse 88 was a resident of a state veterans home at the time of the 89 veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's death, meets 90 the indigent/low-income criteria established by the State Veterans 91 92 Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is the intention of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to use of 93

No. 3166 02/SS26/A731SG PAGE 3 94 indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for any such 95 period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a current 96 surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section and its 97 provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance 98 Act of 1997."

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 99 Executive Director of the Veterans Affairs Board may authorize 100 increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 101 102 exceed ten percent (10%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major objects of 103 104 expenditure are decreased by the corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major 105 object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits." 106

SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, One Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-nine Dollars (\$121,289.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972.

111 SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 112 113 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Veterans Affairs Board for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of State 114 115 General Funds authorized in Senate Bill No. 3126, 2001 Regular Session, for the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997" to be used 116 for the purpose of hiring nursing staff at the four state 117 118 veterans' homes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 119 120,000.00.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2002.

123 **SECTION 9.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 124 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 125 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 126 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
