- 79 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated under the
- 80 provisions of Section 3 shall be requisitioned by the Employment
- 81 Security Commission from the Unemployment Trust Fund maintained by
- 82 the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States as needed for
- 83 the payment of obligations incurred under this appropriation, and
- 84 such monies shall be deposited in the Employment Security
- 85 Administration Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 86 71-5-457, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 87 **SECTION 5.** In addition to any other funds appropriated
- 88 herein, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
- 89 is hereby appropriated out of funds in the Special Employment
- 90 Security Administration Fund to the Employment Security Commission
- 91 for its use as provided in Section 71-5-114, Mississippi Code of

94	SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated under the		
95	provisions of Section 5 shall be requisitioned by the Employment		
96	Security Commission from the Special Employment Security		
97	Administration Fund as needed for the payment of obligations		
98	incurred under this appropriation, and such monies requisitioned		
99	shall be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund		
100	upon receipt.		
101	SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in this act, a total of		
102	Sixteen Million Dollars (\$16,000,000.00) is provided for the		
103	purpose of constructing and/or lease purchasing a new headquarters		
104	facility for the Mississippi Employment Security Commission, and		
105	paying for any costs associated with the construction of		
106	facilities. The funds authorized in this section shall be under		
107	the direction of the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property		
108	Management.		
109	SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by		
110	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the		
111	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upor		
112	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal		
113	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the		
114	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law		
115	SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
