5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Office of State Aid Road
9	Construction of the Mississippi Department of Transportation, for
10	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003

12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
14	Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road

Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 66 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 67 for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and 68 January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 69 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 70 71 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 72 73 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 74 75 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 76 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 77 78 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 79 80 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 81 82 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as

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- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 90 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 91 Section 2, Two Hundred Forty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-one 92 Dollars (\$241,921.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency
- 93 Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972.

94	SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
