## SENATE BILL NO. 3209

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF 1 2 MERIDIAN, MISSISSIPPI, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED 35 YEARS FOR THE SALE OF TREATED EFFLUENT WATER FROM THE CITY'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES, TO 3 4 PRESCRIBE RATES AT WHICH TREATED EFFLUENT WATER SHALL BE SOLD, AND 5 TO DEVELOP, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT WATER WORK FACILITIES TO 6 7 TRANSPORT TREATED EFFLUENT WATER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE 8 LIMITS OF THE CITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. The governing authorities of the City of 10 Meridian, Mississippi, are authorized and empowered, in their 11 discretion, by resolution duly adopted and entered on their 12 13 minutes, to: Enter into contracts and agreements for a term of 14 (a) not to exceed thirty-five (35) years for the sale of treated 15 effluent water from the City of Meridian's wastewater treatment 16 facilities; 17 18 (b) Prescribe rates at which treated effluent water shall be sold; and 19 Develop, design and construct the facilities 20 (C) necessary to transport the treated effluent water within or 21 outside the corporate limits of the City of Meridian. 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23 and after its passage. 24
