SENATE BILL NO. 3211

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO HARVEY ELLIS
2 WILLIAMS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI:

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby full and
5 completely restored to Harvey Ellis Williams of Washington County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction of the crime of grand larceny in 1982 in Washington
8 County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve forty-eight
9 (48) months' probation. His probation was terminated on May 16,
10 1986. Since that time he has conducted himself as a law-abiding
11 and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after its passage.
