SENATE BILL NO. 3212

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOHN EDGAR
2 GRIFFIN, JR. OF CHICKASAW COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to John Edgar Griffin, Jr. of Chickasaw
6 County, Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a
7 result of his conviction of the crime of arson in 1996 in
8 Chickasaw County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve
9 three (3) years in the custody of the Department of Corrections.
10 His sentence was suspended and he was placed on probation for
11 three (3) years. His probation was terminated on May 13, 1999.
12 Since that time he has conducted himself as a law-abiding and
13 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
15 and after its passage.
