- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF 9
- MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi 10
- 11 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 12 state:
- Amend by adding the following section: 13
- Section 272-B. All assets, proceeds and income of the 14
- special trust fund known as the "Mississippi Fire Fighters 15
- Memorial Burn Center Fund" shall be held and invested as 16
- authorized by law and shall be disbursed in trust for the 17
- exclusive purpose of providing for the support and maintenance of 18
- 19 the burn center. The trust fund shall not be encumbered for or
- diverted to other purposes. 20
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be 21
- submitted to the qualified electors at an election held on the 22
- 23 first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2002, as provided
- by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law. 24
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this 25
- amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed 26
- amendment protects the special trust fund known as the 27
- 28 'Mississippi Fire Fighters Memorial Burn Center Fund' by providing
