SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 534

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING RUDOLPH "RUDY" DILL FOR
2 HIS SERVICE TO THE VETERANS' HOME PURCHASE BOARD OF THE STATE OF
3 MISSISSIPPI.

4 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill is an honorably decorated
5 veteran of the United States Army having served in the 7th
6 Infantry Division in the Asiatic Pacific Theater during World War
7 II, and having been awarded the Purple Heart; and

8 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill participated in four major
9 Asiatic Pacific Theater campaigns during World War II involving
10 ten amphibious landings as a platoon sergeant and a first
11 sergeant; and

12 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill also served in the United States
13 Air Force (USAF) from 1945 to 1962 in the 13th Bombardment
14 Squadron, 3rd Bombardment Wing, 5th USAF with honor and
15 distinction and with service in Korea, Japan, the Philippines,
16 Taiwan and Indo-China; and

17 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill also served with distinction in
18 various interior assignments in the United States Air Force as a
19 first sergeant and a sergeant major; and

20 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill has had a distinguished career
21 after retirement from the United States military service; and

22 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill served and retired as President
23 and CEO of the Mississippi Credit Union League, was elected to the
24 Mississippi Credit Union Hall of Fame in 1994; and

25 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill has served as a volunteer in
26 various civic projects too numerous to mention and, in doing so,



27 has contributed to the betterment of his fellowman, community, the
28 state and the nation; and

29 WHEREAS, Rudolph "Rudy" Dill served as a member and Vice
30 Chairman of the Veterans' Home Purchase Board of the State of
31 Mississippi from June 1992 through June 2001; and

32 WHEREAS, during his period of service, Dill's leadership,
33 knowledge and commitment to those he served enabled the Veterans'
34 Home Purchase Board to effectively and efficiently provide funds
35 to Mississippi military veterans for the purchase of homes; and

36 WHEREAS, the members of the Veterans' Home Purchase Board
37 have expressed their high regard for his record of service to the
38 organization; and

39 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to commend the
40 meritorious service of the citizens of this state:

41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
42 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
43 we do hereby commend Rudolph "Rudy" Dill for his leadership and
44 distinguished service as a member of the Veterans' Home Purchase
45 Board and for his faithful performance of the duties and
46 obligations imposed upon that office.

47 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
48 presented to Rudolph "Rudy" Dill, and be made available to the
49 Capitol Press Corps.
