 WHEREAS, our public schools have the care and custody of the

6 majority of Mississippi's children during school hours of each

8 WHEREAS, serious injury and even death are possible results 9 of choking and other breathing difficulties; and

10 WHEREAS, knowledgeable treatment that is swiftly delivered 11 offers the best chance of survival in such situations; and 12 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial for school children to have 13 readily available on their school campuses personnel who are 14 trained to handle such emergencies:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we do hereby encourage the State Department of Education to suggest to the various public school districts that each campus have at least one person on staff trained to properly administer cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and the Heimlich maneuver.
