- 3 WHEREAS, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble
- 4 background, worked throughout his life serving freedom and
- 5 advancing the public good, having been employed as an entertainer,
- 6 union leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of California and
- 7 President of the United States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for
- 9 two terms as the 40th President of the United States of America;
- 10 the second of which he earned the confidence of 3/5 of the
- 11 electorate and was victorious in 49 of the 50 states in the
- 12 general election -- a record unsurpassed in the history of
- 13 American presidential elections; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated
- 15 President, he inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant
- 16 inflation and high unemployment; and
- 17 WHEREAS, during Mr. Reagan's presidency he worked in a
- 18 bipartisan manner to enact his bold agenda of restoring
- 19 accountability and common sense to government which led to an
- 20 unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of
- 21 Americans; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Mr. Reagan's commitment to an active social policy
- 23 agenda for the nation's children helped lower crime and drug use
- 24 in our neighborhoods; and
- 25 WHEREAS, President Reagan's commitment to our armed forces
- 26 contributed to the restoration of pride in America, her values and

- 27 those cherished by the free world, and prepared America's Armed
- 28 Forces to win the Gulf War; and
- 29 WHEREAS, President Reagan's vision of "peace through
- 30 strength" led to the end of the Cold War and the ultimate demise
- 31 of the Soviet Union, guaranteeing basic human rights for millions
- 32 of people; and
- 33 WHEREAS, on February 6, 2002, Ronald Reagan will have reached
- 34 the age of ninety-one years:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
