He graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree from 10 Tougaloo College, Tougaloo, Mississippi and received his Master of 11 Science Degree in Secondary Education from Alcorn State University 12 13 in 1990, and is furthering his studies at the University of Southern Mississippi in the area of Microbiology; and 14 WHEREAS, he is one of the most eligible bachelors in the 15 State of Mississippi; and 16 WHEREAS, Darryl is known throughout Adams County for his hard 17 work for all of the citizens of this county. His first cousin Robert Johnson, a lawyer, is 58 59 also a State Senator representing Adams and other counties; and
