WHEREAS, Andrew's designs in stained glass have recently been completed by PRGS for St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church, Madison, and St. Peter's by the Sea Episcopal Church, Gulfport, First United Methodist Church, Tupelo and the Paris-Yates Chapel, University of Mississippi, Oxford; and

WHEREAS, Andrew served on the board of the Arts Alliance of 24 Jackson/Hinds County, the Craftsman's Guild of Mississippi, and 25 26 Millsaps Arts and Lecture Series.
