## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 571

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING CAROLYN  
2 HENRY, STAR AMATEUR TENNIS PLAYER FROM CRYSTAL SPRINGS,  
3 MISSISSIPPI, UPON HER INDUCTION INTO THE 40TH MISSISSIPPI SPORTS  
4 HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 2002.

5 WHEREAS, the Jackson Touchdown Club and Mississippi Sports  
6 Hall of Fame has unveiled the Class of 2002 of the 40th  
7 Anniversary Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame, which features  
8 Carolyn Henry, star amateur tennis player from Crystal Springs,  
9 Mississippi, who has won regional and national championships and  
10 served as a tennis administrator; and

11 WHEREAS, her sports career is a matter of record: she was a  
12 superb tennis player at Crystal Springs High and MSCW; between  
13 1972 and 1984, she placed first or second in singles or doubles  
14 play in 142 tennis tournaments; strong competitor in matches  
15 hosted by the Mississippi Tennis Association, the Southern Tennis  
16 Association, and the United States Tennis Association; from 1968  
17 to 2001, she captured first place titles 55 times, second place  
18 finishes 19 times, and 3rd place on four occasions; has played all  
19 across the nation with numerous partners on clay, hard court and  
20 grass surfaces; represents Mississippi in Senior Cup competition  
21 and has represented the U.S. in several international matches;  
22 served as President of the Mississippi Tennis Association; an  
23 accomplished award winning tennis professional who taught tennis  
24 for several decades; remains active in the sport and is a  
25 nationally ranked player; inducted into the MSCW Hall of Fame in  
26 1945 and in the Mississippi Tennis Hall of Fame in 1993; and



27           WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this  
28 outstanding athlete who has brought honor to her university and to  
29 the State of Mississippi:

30           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
31 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That  
32 we do hereby commend and congratulate Carolyn Henry, star amateur  
33 tennis player from Crystal Springs, Mississippi, upon her  
34 induction into the 40th Anniversary Mississippi Sports Hall of  
35 Fame Class of 2002, and wish her and her family continued success  
36 in all their future endeavors.

37           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to  
38 Carolyn Henry at induction ceremonies to be held on April 19,  
39 2002, in Vicksburg, Mississippi, and be made available to the  
40 Capitol Press Corps.
