- 19 director; also a member of the Jackson State, SWAC and the
- 20 National Association of Collegiate Athletic Directors Hall of
- 21 Fame; and
- 22 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
- 23 outstanding coach and athletic director who brought honor to his
- 24 university and to the State of Mississippi:
