## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 611

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE 1 MISSISSIPPI STATE UNIVERSITY BULLDOG BASKETBALL TEAM FOR WINNING 2 3 THE SEC TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOR SETTING A SCHOOL RECORD 4 FOR SEASON VICTORIES. 5 WHEREAS, the Mississippi State University Mens Basketball Team won the SEC Tournament Championship; and 6 WHEREAS, the Bulldogs set a new all-time single-season school 7 standard with 27 wins during the 2001-2002 campaign, breaking the 8 9 previous mark of 26 victories set by MSU's 1995-1996 Final Four 10 Team; and WHEREAS, MSU's 27 wins and 77.1 winning percentage tied with 11 SEC Champion Alabama for the best marks among all Southeastern 12 Conference teams this season; and 13 WHEREAS, MSU earned its eighth postseason tournament 14 appearance since 1990 with this year's second-round showing in the 15 16 NCAA Tournament; and 17 WHEREAS, Mississippi State has now advanced beyond the first round of the NCAA Tournament during each of the team's last three 18 tournament appearances; and 19 WHEREAS, the Bulldogs established new single-season school 20 standards for most points scored (2,582), most rebounds (1,359), 21 most assists (566) and most steals (294); and 22 WHEREAS, after claiming the school's second SEC Tournament 23 Championship with wins over nationally ranked Florida and Alabama, 24 as well as LSU, the Bulldogs earned their highest seeding ever 25 (No. 3 seed in the Midwest Regional bracket) in NCAA Tournament 26 play; and 27

WHEREAS, the Bulldogs led the Southeastern Conference in team 28 field-goal percentage (48.0%) and rebounding margin (+6.5 rpg), 29 while ranking second among the league leaders in assists (16.2 30 apq) and three-point field-qoal percentage defense (30.1%); and 31 32 WHEREAS, Mississippi State matched the current all-time school standard by opening the 2001-2002 season with 11 33 consecutive victories, equaling the school's all-time record of 11 34 straight wins to open a basketball season previously set by the 35 1957-1958 MSU squad; and 36

37 WHEREAS, the Bulldogs were led by Coach Rick Stansbury, who 38 became the second Bulldog basketball coach in school history to 39 take more than one State team to postseason tournament play; and 40 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature of the State of 41 Mississippi to commend the noteworthy accomplishments of the 42 student athletes of this state:
