SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 618

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-13-117, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO ADMINISTER THE MISSISSIPPI MEDICAID PROGRAM BY EXECUTIVE ORDER WITHIN THE 3 4 APPROPRIATIONS AVAILABLE TO THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID, INCLUDING 6 THE FOLLOWING AUTHORITY: 7 (A) TO ESTABLISH FOR RECIPIENTS THE AMOUNT, DURATION, SCOPE AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH MEDICAL 8 ASSISTANCE; (B) TO ESTABLISH THE TYPES OF CARE AND SERVICE TO BE 9 AVAILABLE TO ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS; (C) TO ESTABLISH SUCH RULES AND 10 REGULATIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF 11 THE STATE PLAN; AND (D) TO SECURE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FEDERAL 12 FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION AVAILABLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES." 13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE 14 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint Rules 15 16 of the Senate and the House are hereby suspended for the purpose of requesting the drafting, introduction, consideration and 17 18 passage, regardless of any deadlines imposed by said rules, of a bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-13-117, MISSISSIPPI CODE 19 OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO ADMINISTER THE MISSISSIPPI 20 MEDICAID PROGRAM BY EXECUTIVE ORDER WITHIN THE APPROPRIATIONS 21 AVAILABLE TO THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING 22 23 AUTHORITY: (A) TO ESTABLISH FOR RECIPIENTS THE AMOUNT, DURATION, 24 SCOPE AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH MEDICAL ASSISTANCE; (B) TO ESTABLISH THE TYPES OF CARE AND SERVICE TO BE AVAILABLE TO 25 26 ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS; (C) TO ESTABLISH SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE 27 PLAN; AND (D) TO SECURE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FEDERAL FINANCIAL 2.8 29 PARTICIPATION AVAILABLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
