SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 618

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION
3 AND PASSAGE OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-13-117,
4 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO ADMINISTER
5 THE MISSISSIPPI MEDICAID PROGRAM BY EXECUTIVE ORDER WITHIN THE
6 APPROPRIATIONS AVAILABLE TO THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID, INCLUDING
7 THE FOLLOWING AUTHORITY: (A) TO ESTABLISH FOR RECIPIENTS THE
8 AMOUNT, DURATION, SCOPE AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH MEDICAL
9 ASSISTANCE; (B) TO ESTABLISH THE TYPES OF CARE AND SERVICE TO BE
10 AVAILABLE TO ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS; (C) TO ESTABLISH SUCH RULES AND
11 REGULATIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF
12 THE STATE PLAN; AND (D) TO SECURE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FEDERAL
13 FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION AVAILABLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE
15 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint Rules
16 of the Senate and the House are hereby suspended for the purpose
17 of requesting the drafting, introduction, consideration and
18 passage, regardless of any deadlines imposed by said rules, of a
19 bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-13-117, MISSISSIPPI CODE
20 OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO ADMINISTER THE MISSISSIPPI
21 MEDICAID PROGRAM BY EXECUTIVE ORDER WITHIN THE APPROPRIATIONS
22 AVAILABLE TO THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING
23 AUTHORITY: (A) TO ESTABLISH FOR RECIPIENTS THE AMOUNT, DURATION,
24 SCOPE AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH MEDICAL ASSISTANCE; (B) TO
25 ESTABLISH THE TYPES OF CARE AND SERVICE TO BE AVAILABLE TO
26 ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS; (C) TO ESTABLISH SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS
27 AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE
28 PLAN; AND (D) TO SECURE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FEDERAL FINANCIAL
29 PARTICIPATION AVAILABLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
