SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 32

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CAREER OF MR. SCOTT C. BIGGERS
2 UPON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT AFTER 25 YEARS OF SERVICE IN
3 LAW ENFORCEMENT.

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Scott C. Biggers, a native of Eupora,
5 Mississippi, has retired after 25 years of outstanding service in
6 law enforcement; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Biggers recently retired as Captain of the
8 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics, where he managed the day-to-day
9 operations of the Jackson District Office; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Biggers is the son of Bessie E. Biggers and the
11 late Robert Melvin Biggers, Sr., of Eupora, Mississippi; and

12 WHEREAS, after graduating from Eupora High School in 1972,
13 Mr. Biggers attended the University of Southern Mississippi, where
14 he received a Bachelor's Degree in Athletic Administration; and

15 WHEREAS, commissioned as a law enforcement officer in 1976,
16 Mr. Biggers served as a Police Officer in Leland and Ridgeland;
17 Deputy Sheriff in Madison; Commander of the Madison County
18 Narcotics Unit; Undercover Operations Instructor at the
19 Mississippi Law Enforcement Academy; Post Traumatic Syndrome
20 Instructor at the National Training Academy in Georgia;
21 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics Commander - Intelligence;
22 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics Acting Major - Central Region,
23 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area, Undercover Pool, Diversion,
24 Special Weapons and Tactics, Interdiction, Training and Special
25 Operations; Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics Master Sergeant,
26 Sergeant and Special Agent; Federal Bureau of Investigation and
27 Drug Enforcement Administration Special Task Forces Special Agent;



28 Jackson International Airport Police Officer; United States
29 Department of Agriculture Contract Investigator; and Security
30 Officer; and

31 WHEREAS, Mr. Biggers has completed special training at the
32 Drug Enforcement Administration National Law Enforcement Academy,
33 Drug Enforcement Administration Academy for State and Local
34 Officers and Drug Enforcement Administration Drug Unit Commander
35 School; and

36 WHEREAS, throughout his long and distinguished career in law
37 enforcement, Mr. Biggers has received numerous awards including
38 the Governor's Meritorious Service Award in 1979 and the
39 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics Meritorious Service Award in 1988;

41 WHEREAS, in addition to his law enforcement responsibilities,
42 Mr. Biggers is an active member of Mountain Creek Baptist Church
43 in Florence, Mississippi; and

44 WHEREAS, Mr. Biggers has been lovingly supported in all his
45 endeavors by his wife, Deb Collier Biggers and his daughter,
46 Victoria S. Biggers; and

47 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that the Senate recognizes
48 the long public service of dedicated law enforcement professionals
49 such as Mr. Biggers, whose expertise has enhanced the
50 effectiveness of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics and brought
51 great credibility and honor to many law enforcement agencies in
52 this state:

53 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
54 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend the career of Mr. Scott C.
55 Biggers upon the occasion of his retirement after 25 years of
56 outstanding public service as a law enforcement professional and
57 express our heartiest wishes for success in all his future
58 endeavors.

60 Bureau of Narcotics to retire the badge of Captain Scott C.
61 Biggers in commendation of his service.
