SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 79

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MSU BULLDOG BASKETBALL PLAYER, MARIO
2 AUSTIN, FOR BEING SELECTED AS THE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER OF THE SEC
3 TOURNAMENT AND FOR HAVING AN OUTSTANDING SEASON.

4 WHEREAS, MSU Bulldog basketball player, Mario Austin, was
5 selected as the Most Valuable Player of the SEC Tournament; and

6 WHEREAS, in addition to being selected the Most Valuable
7 Player, Mario was a second-team All-SEC selection and a two-time
8 SEC Player of the Week honoree for the Bulldogs; and

9 WHEREAS, Mario Austin led the 2001-2002 Bulldogs in scoring
10 and rebounding and was ranked second in the conference in
11 field-goal percentage; and

12 WHEREAS, Mario Austin was also named to the United States
13 Basketball Writers Association All-District IV Team and was
14 selected to the All-Tournament Team in the 2001 Las Vegas Classic;

16 WHEREAS, Mario Austin's determined and aggressive style of
17 play was instrumental in leading the Bulldogs to one of the most
18 successful seasons in school history; and

19 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature to recognize and
20 commend the noteworthy accomplishments of the student athletes of
21 the State of Mississippi:

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
23 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend MSU Bulldog, Mario Austin,
24 for being selected as the Most Valuable Player in the SEC
25 Tournament and for having an outstanding season, and we wish him
26 continued success in his endeavors.
