## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 251: Social security numbers; state agencies take steps to prevent inadvertent disclosure.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 15 **SECTION 1.** When any state agency mails, delivers,
- 16 circulates, publishes, distributes, transmits, or otherwise
- 17 disseminates, in any form or manner, information or material that
- 18 contains the social security number of an individual, the agency
- 19 shall take such steps as may be reasonably necessary to prevent
- 20 the inadvertent disclosure of the individual's social security
- 21 number to members of the general public or to persons other than
- 22 those persons who, in the performance of their duties and
- 23 responsibilities, have a lawful and legitimate need to know the
- 24 individual's social security number. State agencies shall be in
- 25 compliance with this act on or before July 1, 2003.
- SECTION 2. Section 35-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 27 amended as follows:
- 35-3-13. All chancery clerks, of all counties of the State
- 29 of Mississippi, shall record, without any cost whatsoever to any
- 30 person of the Armed Forces of the United States residing in the
- 31 same county as the chancery clerk, all honorable discharges and
- 32 all certificates of service of any and all members of the Armed
- 33 Forces of the United States of America who have served in the
- 34 Armed Forces of the United States, including the army, navy and
- 35 marine, coast guard and nurses corps.
- The board of supervisors of all counties shall furnish to the

- chancery clerk \* \* \* all necessary supplies and equipment for the 37 38 recording of these instruments, and allow out of the general fund of the county the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for recording the 39 discharge certificate. All certified copies will be furnished 40 free without cost either to the soldier, sailor, marine, coast 41 guardsman, nurse or the county. 42 The chancery clerk of all counties shall keep a record of all 43 honorable discharges and certificates of discharge in a separate 44 record <u>safeguarded</u> and <u>protected</u> from theft, and definitely marked 45 "Record of Discharged Members of the Armed Forces." The chancery 46 clerk shall \* \* \* furnish certified copies of the discharge or 47 discharge certificate of any veteran when so requested by the 48 veteran, his dependents or his authorized representative; however, 49 before furnishing any copy of the discharge or discharge 50 certificate, the chancery clerk must verify the identity and 51 52 relationship to the veteran of the person requesting the copy and must obtain and maintain on file a signed consent for the release 53 of information from the veteran, dependent or authorized 54 55 <u>representative</u>. SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 56

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN A STATE AGENCY MAILS, DELIVERS OR OTHERWISE DISSEMINATES INFORMATION OR MATERIAL THAT CONTAINS THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF AN INDIVIDUAL, THE AGENCY SHALL TAKE 3 4 SUCH STEPS AS MAY BE REASONABLY NECESSARY TO PREVENT THE 5 INADVERTENT DISCLOSURE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC OR TO PERSONS OTHER THAN THOSE PERSONS 6 HAVING A LEGITIMATE AND LAWFUL NEED TO KNOW THE INDIVIDUAL'S 7 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES; TO 8 9 AMEND SECTION 35-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE 10 CHANCERY CLERKS TO SAFEGUARD THE RECORD OF DISCHARGED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES AND TO VERIFY THE IDENTITY AND RELATIONSHIP TO 11 THE VETERAN OF PERSONS REQUESTING COPIES OF DISCHARGE RECORDS; AND 12 13 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
