## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 793: State highway system; add segments in Simpson County.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 11 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following segments of highway are
  12 designated as state highways and placed under the jurisdicti
- 12 designated as state highways and placed under the jurisdiction of
- 13 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
- 14 maintenance; and such highways, together with the highways
- 15 designated in Section 65-3-3 and all other laws adding links to
- 16 the designated state highway system are declared to be the state
- 17 highway system of Mississippi:
- 18 <u>Southern District Simpson County:</u>
- 19 Mississippi Highway 469 beginning at Harrisville near
- the old school building, Section 34, Township 2 North,
- 21 Range 2 East, 7.2 miles north of its intersection with
- 22 Mississippi Highway 28 at Union, thence .46 miles
- through Harrisville and ending at the beginning of state
- 24 maintenance of Mississippi Highway 469 in Section 27,
- Township 2 North, Range 2 East.
- 26 <u>Southern District Simpson County:</u>
- 27 Mississippi Highway 540 beginning at its intersection
- with Mississippi Highway 541 and extending easterly for
- 29 a distance of 1077.75 feet.
- 30 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
- 31 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
- 32 the highway segments described under subsection (1) of this

- 33 section whenever such highway segments have been brought up to
- 34 commission standards.
- 35 **SECTION 2.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
- 36 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 37 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
- 38 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
- 39 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
- 40 the state highway system of Mississippi:
- Northern District Coahoma County:
- That segment of highway beginning six-tenths (.6) of a
- 43 mile east of the termination of state maintenance of
- 44 Mississippi Highway 316 and extending northwesterly to
- its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
- 46 61, and that segment of highway extending westerly from
- its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
- 48 61 to its intersection with the eastern city limits of
- 49 Friars Point, Mississippi.
- 50 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
- 51 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
- 52 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
- 53 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
- 54 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
- 55 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
- 56 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.
- 57 **SECTION 3.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
- 58 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 59 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
- 60 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
- 61 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
- 62 the state highway system of Mississippi:
- 63 <u>Northern District DeSoto County:</u>
- That segment of road beginning at the intersection of
- Mississippi 301 and Mississippi 304 and extending southerly
- to Arkabutla Dam.
- 67 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
- 68 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of

- 69 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
- 70 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
- 71 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
- 72 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
- 73 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.
- 74 **SECTION 4.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
- 75 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 76 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
- 77 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
- 78 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
- 79 the state highway system of Mississippi:
- 80 <u>Northern District Carroll County:</u>
- Old Mississippi Highway 430 from the Leflore/Carroll
- 82 County line southeasterly to its intersection with
- Mississippi Highway 17, a distance of approximately thirteen
- 84 (13) miles.
- 85 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
- 86 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
- 87 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
- 88 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
- 89 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
- 90 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
- 91 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.
- 92 **SECTION 5.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
- 93 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 94 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
- 95 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
- 96 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
- 97 the state highway system of Mississippi:
- 98 <u>Central District Kemper County:</u>
- 99 That portion of Old Highway 463 from Mississippi
- Highway 16 northerly to Mississippi Highway 397.
- 101 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
- 102 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
- 103 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
- 104 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of

105	highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
106	utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
107	highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.
108	SECTION 6. (1) The following highway is designated as a
109	state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
110	Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
111	highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
112	links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
113	the state highway system of Mississippi:
114	Central District - Bolivar and Sunflower Counties:
115	A roadway segment beginning at or near Shelby and
116	extending easterly to at or near Parchman.
117	(2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
118	over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
119	the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
120	section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
121	highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
122	utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
123	highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.
124	SECTION 7. (1) The following segment of highway is
125	designated as a state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of
126	the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
127	maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways
128	designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to
129	the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
130	highway system of Mississippi:
131	Southern District - Jefferson Davis County:
132	That portion of Mississippi 42 within the corporate
133	limits of the Town of Prentiss beginning at the end of
134	state maintenance on Mississippi 42 at its intersection
135	with an old abandoned railway and proceeding in a
136	northeasterly direction along Columbia Avenue
137	(Mississippi 42) for approximately seven hundred (700)
138	feet to the intersection of Columbia Avenue (Mississippi
139	42) and Third Street.

(2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take

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- 141 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
- 142 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
- 143 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
- 144 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
- 145 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
- 146 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.
- 147 **SECTION 8.** (1) The following segment of highway is
- 148 designated as a state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of
- 149 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
- 150 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways
- 151 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to
- 152 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
- 153 highway system of Mississippi:
- 154 <u>Central District Rankin County:</u>
- A three-mile section of Old U.S. 49 beginning at U.S. 80
- and extending southerly to new U.S. 49 in the City of
- 157 Richland.
- 158 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
- 159 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
- 160 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
- 161 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
- 162 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
- 163 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
- 164 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.
- 165 **SECTION 9.** The following segment of highway is designated as
- 166 a state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the
- 167 Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
- 168 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways
- 169 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to
- 170 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
- 171 highway system of Mississippi:
- Northern District Union County:
- An extension of Mississippi 30 in the City of New Albany
- beginning at its intersection with Mississippi 178 and
- 175 extending east and northerly to its intersection with Sam
- 176 T. Barkley Road.

177 **SECTION 10**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 178 and after July 1, 2002.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN SIMPSON, COAHOMA, DESOTO, CARROLL, KEMPER, BOLIVAR, SUNFLOWER, JEFFERSON DAVIS AND RANKIN COUNTIES AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE; TO EXTEND A SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI 30 IN THE CITY OF NEW ALBANY AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENT OF HIGHWAY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
