REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1555: Walnut Grove Correctional Facility; increase maximum age of offenders.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 47-5-943, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

47-5-943. The Mississippi Department of Corrections shall 8 contract with the Walnut Grove Correctional Authority or the 9 10 governing authorities of the Municipality of Walnut Grove, Leake 11 County, Mississippi, to provide for the private housing, care and control of five hundred (500) juvenile offenders who are in the 12 custody of the Department of Corrections at a maximum security 13 facility in Walnut Grove; the department also may contract with 14 such authority or governing authorities for the housing at the 15 Walnut Grove facility of an additional two hundred fifty (250) 16 juvenile offenders in the department's custody. The maximum age 17 18 of any offender housed in this facility shall be twenty (20) years. A county or circuit judge shall not order any juvenile to 19 be housed in the correctional facility authorized in Sections 20 47-5-943 through 47-5-953. Commitment of juvenile offenders shall 21 not be to this facility, but shall be to the jurisdiction of the 22 department. The commissioner shall assign newly sentenced 23 offenders to an appropriate facility consistent with public 24 25 safety. Any facility owned or leased by the Walnut Grove Correctional Authority or the Municipality of Walnut Grove for 26 this purpose shall be designed, constructed, operated and 27

maintained in accordance with American Correctional Association standards, and shall comply with all constitutional standards of the United States and the State of Mississippi and with all court orders that may now or hereinafter be applicable to the facility. The contract must comply with Sections 47-5-1211 through 47-5-1227.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

35 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-943, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM NUMBER AND MAXIMUM AGE OF JUVENILE 3 OFFENDERS THAT MAY BE HOUSED BY THE WALNUT GROVE CORRECTIONAL 4 AUTHORITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
