 - 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

27 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 2.8 Permanent: Full Time 60 29 Part Time 65 30 Time-Limited: Full Time Part Time 0 31 32 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 33 equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the 34 Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), 35 whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. 36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 37 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 38 39 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 41 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 42 43 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 44 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 45 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 46 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 47 48 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 49 50 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 51 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 52 53 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 54 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 55 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 56 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 57 58 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 59 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 60 the requirements of this provision are met. 61

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

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63	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.		
64	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be		
65	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which ar		
66	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this		
67	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.		
68	SECTION 3. The funds herein approved for expenditure, excep		
69	and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which		
70	shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations		
71	shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the		
72	state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent		
73	(1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills		
74	of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.		
75	SECTION 4. The money herein approved for expenditure shall		
76	be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, office		
77	or officers, in the manner provided by law.		
78	SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from		
79	and after July 1, 2002.
