We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1774: Appropriation; Board of Nursing.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 74 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 75 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 76 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 77 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 78 79 SECTION 5.
