REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1775: Appropriation; Oil and Gas Board.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Oil and Gas Conservation Fund, for
8	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Oil and Gas
9	Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
10	June 30, 2003\$ 1,741,610.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
13	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
14	expenditure:

17	Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits \$ 1,169,525.00

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AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 26 Permanent: Full Time..... 33 27 Part Time..... 28 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 29 Part Time..... 0 30 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 31 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 32 equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the 33 Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), 34 whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. 35 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 39 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 40 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 41 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 42 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 43 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 44 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 45 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 46 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 47 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 48 49 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 50 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 51 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 52 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 53 54 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 55 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 56 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 57

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- 58 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement
- 59 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as
- 60 the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 67 **SECTION 3.** With the funds provided herein, it is the
- 68 intention of the Legislature that the State Oil and Gas Board
- 69 purchase liability insurance.
- 70 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 71 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 72 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 73 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 74 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 75 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 76 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 77 and after July 1, 2002.
