27 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 2.8 Permanent: Full Time 30 29 Part Time 0 30 Time-Limited: Full Time Part Time 31 0 32 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 33 equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the 34 Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), 35 whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. 36 37 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 38 39 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 41 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 42 43 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 44 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 45 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 46 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 47 48 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 49 50 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 51 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 52 53 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 54 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 55 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 56 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 57 58 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 59 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 60 the requirements of this provision are met. 61
