## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1798: Appropriation; Arts Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Arts Commission for the 8 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 9 .....\$ 10 1,316,770.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 12 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts 13 14 Commission which is comprised of special source funds and donations collected by or otherwise available to the commission, 15 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for 16 17 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003. .....\$ 1,672,434.00. 18 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 19 Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below 20 21 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 22 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 23 Personal Services: 2.4 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 536,145.00 25

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

48 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 49 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 50 51 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 52 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 53 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 54 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 55 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 56 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 57 58 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 59 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 60 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 61 62 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for

63 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 64 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 65 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 66 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 67 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 68 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 69 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 70 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 71 the requirements of this provision are met. 72

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance withthe terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

79 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 80 Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand 81 Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education 82 Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, 83 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the following:

84 Training of educators and promotion

of arts programs in public schools . . . \$100,000.00 85 Miscellaneous grants and programs . . . . \$350,000.00 86 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 87 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars 88 89 appropriated in the major object of expenditure "Subsidies, Loans and Grants," designated for the "Challenge Program," specific 90 amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called the Arts 91 Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts 92 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse 93 94 into the State General Fund and may be expended by the commission in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature. 95 Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited to the credit 96 97 of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission upon appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of the 98

99 Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts 100 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be 101 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of 102 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source available not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), that may become available to the Commission in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 110 111 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 112 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 113 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 114 115 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 116 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002. 117
