## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1799: Appropriation; expenses of Legislature, monthly expense, Legislative Budget Office, PEER Committee.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12	SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 71 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying 72 73 the state's share of various assessments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 74 75 .....\$ 300,174.00. The Legislature shall have the authority to 84 escalate its budget and expend funds from the Legislative 85 86 Extraordinary Session Expense Revolving Fund, as authorized in 87 Section 5-1-57, Mississippi Code of 1972, in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 88 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 89 The authority granted in this section is provided for the purpose of 90 91 paying the expenses of the members of the Legislature incurred during any Extraordinary Session of the Legislature occurring 92 during the period beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 93 94 2003.

SECTION 5. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 95 96 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State General Fund to the credit of the Joint Legislative 97 Reapportionment Committee, pursuant to House Bill No. 1607, 98 Regular Session of 2001, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 99 2002, and ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 30,000.00. 100 101 SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State General Fund to the credit of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, pursuant to House Bill No. 1607, Regular Session of 2001, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 106 30, 2003.....\$ 200,000.00.

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 107 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 108 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 109 110 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 111 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 112 113 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002, with the exception of Section 4 which 114 shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. 115
