REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1800: Appropriation; benefit payments to retirants under the former Teachers' Retirement System.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees 8 of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of 9 10 paying supplementary annuities and additional annuities to retirants under the former Teachers' Retirement System, in 11 accordance with Section 25-11-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, to be 12 known as The Bea Barnard Memorial Fund, for the fiscal year 13 beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 14 15\$ 32,400.00. SECTION 2. The funds provided in Section 1 shall be known as 16 The Bea Barnard Memorial Fund, so named after Bea Barnard, a 17 18 native of Lee County and the first publicly elected woman Superintendent of Education in the State of Mississippi, serving 19 Sharkey County in that capacity for twenty-four (24) years. 20 Barnard died on May 31, 1990, having been a recipient of this fund 2.1 for many years. The minimum payment to retired teachers qualified 22 to receive retirement benefits from the funds appropriated under 23 the provisions of Section 1 shall be Six Hundred Twenty-five 24 25 Dollars (\$625.00) per month, and the maximum benefit paid to such retirants shall be Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) per month. 26
