REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1806: Appropriation; Library Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
15	Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds
16	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the
17	purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal
18	year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003

20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
22	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 49 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 50 51 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 52 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 53 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 54 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 55 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 56 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 57 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 58 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 59 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 60 61 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 62 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases

this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 63 64 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 65 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 66 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 67 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 68 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 69 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 70 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 71 72 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 73

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 31 and June 30.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

109 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 110 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the 111 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 112 Committee for Fiscal Year 2004.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated herein, not less than One Million Eighty-six Thousand Three Hundred Forty Dollars (\$1,086,340.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Database.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 122 123 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 124 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 125 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 126 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 127 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 128 and after July 1, 2002. 129
