REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1813: Appropriation; Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

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- 63 Executive Director of the Office of Capital Post-Conviction
- 64 Counsel may authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in
- 65 total amounts not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the
- 66 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided
- 67 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a
- 68 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be
- 69 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
- 70 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

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- SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 73 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 74 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 75 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 76 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 77 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 78 and after July 1, 2002, with the exception of Section 4 which
- 79 shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE OFFICE OF CAPITAL POST-CONVICTION COUNSEL OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR THE FISCAL YEARS 2002 AND 2003.
