S. B. No. 2225: Enrollment in Kindergarten or Grade 1; prescribe evidence of date of birth required for.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. Section 37-15-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 37-15-1. The State Board of Education shall prepare and 8 provide necessary forms for keeping permanent records and 9 10 cumulative folders for each pupil in the public schools of the 11 state. In the permanent record and cumulative folders, the teachers and principals shall keep information concerning the 12 pupil's date of birth, as verified by the documentation authorized 13 in this section, record of attendance, grades and withdrawal from 14 the school, including the date of any expulsion from the school 15 system and a description of the student's act or behavior 16 resulting in the expulsion. The records also shall contain 17 18 information pertaining to immunization and such other information as the State Board of Education may prescribe. The cumulative 19
