REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2289: Judicial office vacancies; gubernatorial appointment for remainder of term.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-849, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

23-15-849. (1) Vacancies in the office of * * * circuit 8 judge or chancellor shall be filled for the unexpired term by the 9 10 qualified electors at the next regular election for state officers 11 or for representatives in Congress occurring more than nine (9) months after the existence of the vacancy to be filled, and the 12 term of office of the person elected to fill a vacancy shall 13 commence on the first Monday in January following his election. 14 Upon the occurring of such a vacancy, the Governor shall appoint a 15 qualified person from the district in which the vacancy exists to 16 hold the office and discharge the duties thereof until the vacancy 17 18 shall be filled by election as * * * provided <u>in this subsection</u>.

(a) If half or more than half of the term remains, 19 (2)20 vacancies in the office of judge of the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals shall be filled for the unexpired term by the qualified 21 electors at the next regular election for state officers or for 22 representatives in Congress occurring more than nine (9) months 23 after the existence of the vacancy to be filled, and the term of 24 25 office of the person elected to fill a vacancy shall commence on the first Monday in January following his election. If less than 26 27 half of the term remains, vacancies in the office of judge of the

Supreme Court or Court of Appeals shall be filled for the 28 29 remaining unexpired term solely by appointment as provided in this 30 subsection. (b) Upon occurrence of a vacancy, the Governor shall 31 appoint a qualified person from the district in which the vacancy 32 exists to hold the office and discharge the duties thereof as 33 follows: 34 (i) If less than half of the term remains, the 35 appointee shall serve until expiration of the term; 36 (ii) If half or more than half of the term 37 remains, the appointee shall serve until the vacancy shall be 38 filled by election as provided in subsection (1) of this section 39 for judges of the circuit and chancery courts. Elections to fill 40 vacancies in the office of judge of the Supreme Court or Court of 41 Appeals shall be held, conducted, returned and the persons elected 42 commissioned in accordance with the law governing regular 43 44 elections for judges of the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals insofar as they may be applicable. 45 (c) This subsection (2) shall apply to all 46 47 gubernatorial appointees to the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals who have not stood for special election as of the date Senate Bill 48 2289, 2002 Regular Session, goes into effect as if Senate Bill No. 49 2289, 2002 Regular Session, were in full force and effect on the 50 day of each of their appointments. 51 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 52 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 53 54 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 55 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 56 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 57 58 extended.

59 **SECTION 3**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 60 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 61 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-849, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT APPOINTEES FOR CERTAIN VACANT JUDICIAL POSITIONS 3 SHALL SERVE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.
