S. B. No. 2441: School guidance counselors; define authorized program activities.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Beginning with the 2002-2003 school year, 4 **SECTION 1.** (1) the assignment of K-12 school guidance counselors to the 5 particular schools within the district shall be at the discretion 6 of the local school board with the following restrictions: 7 8 No individual shall be employed as a school guidance counselor without a minimum of a Master's Degree in 9 Guidance and Counseling, or in an emergency situation, an 10 appropriate certification as determined by the Commission on 11 Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and Licensure 12 and Development; and 13 (b) School guidance counselors shall provide the 14 following comprehensive counseling services: 15 16 (i) Academic and personal/social counseling; (ii) Student assessment and assessment counseling; 17 (iii) Career and educational counseling; 18 (iv) Individual and group counseling 19 (large/small); 20 (v) Crisis intervention and preventive counseling; 21 (vi) Referrals to community agencies; 2.2 23 (vii) Educational consultations and collaboration with teachers, administrators, parents and community leaders; 24

(viii) Educational and career placement services;

30	(2) School guidance counselors shall abide by the American

36	and after July 1, 2002.
