## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2922: Forestry; create Forestry Economic Development and Strategic Planning Act of 2002.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**SECTION 1.** This act shall be known as the "Mississippi 7 Forestry Inventory and Strategic Planning Act of 2002." 8 **SECTION 2.** (1) (a) There is hereby created the Mississippi 9 Institute for Forest Inventory. The institute shall be governed 10 11 by a board of directors. The board shall consist of eleven (11) 12 members. The Director of the Mississippi Automated Resource Information System; the Executive Director of the Mississippi 13 Development Authority, or his designee; the Director of the Forest 14 and Wildlife Research Center at Mississippi State University, or 15 his designee; and the State Forester, or his designee; shall be ex 16 officio members with full voting power. The Governor shall 17 appoint four (4) members with the advice and consent of the 18 19 Senate. The members shall be appointed from the state at large. The Governor shall appoint one (1) member from each of the 20 21 following categories: a private nonindustrial forest landowner, a Mississippi registered forester, a certified wildlife or fisheries 22 biologist, and a representative of an environmental organization. 23

The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint three (3)

The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint one (1) member from

members from the state at large with the advice and consent of the

each of the following categories: the timber harvesting industry,

the forest products industry, and a citizen with forestry related

- 30 (c) Members of the board may be reimbursed for mileage
- 31 and actual and necessary expenses as provided under Section
- 32 25-3-41.
- 33 (d) The Chairman of the Senate Forestry Committee and
- 34 the Chairman of the House Agriculture Committee shall serve as
- 35 members of the Joint Institute for Forest Inventory Oversight
- 36 Committee. For attending meetings, the legislators shall receive
- 37 per diem and expenses from their respective contingent expense
- 38 funds at the rate authorized for committee meetings when the
- 39 Legislature is not in session. No per diem and expenses will be
- 40 paid for attending meetings when the Legislature is in session.
- 41 (2) The board shall appoint a director of the institute who
- 42 serves at the will and pleasure of the board.
- 43 (3) The board shall have the following powers:
- 44 (a) To apply for, accept and expend any funds, grants
- 45 or gifts from any public or private sources in furtherance of the
- 46 institute's duties;
- 47 (b) To expend funds by appropriation or directly from
- 48 any federal, local or private sources;
- 49 (c) Enter into contracts and execute all instruments to
- 50 carry out the duties of the institute;
- 51 (d) To authorize the executive director with the
- 52 approval of the board to execute all contracts and agreements and
- 53 to employ such personnel as may be required to carry out the
- 54 duties of the institute; and
- (e) To do all acts necessary to carry out the duties of
- 56 the institute.
- 57 (4) All funds received by the institute shall be deposited
- 58 in the State Treasury for the use of the institute.
- 59 **SECTION 3.** (1) The duties and responsibilities of the
- 60 Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory shall include, but are
- 61 not limited to, the following:
- 62 (a) To facilitate the development and implementation of
- 63 a statewide forest resource inventory necessary for a sustainable
- 64 forest-based economy on or before July 1, 2004, and thereafter on

- 65 a continuing basis with updated published data;
- (b) Analyze and publish a detailed report of
- 67 Mississippi's forest resource inventory by January 1, 2005;
- 68 (c) Conduct and publish data for subsequent and
- 69 supporting inventories of forest resources in the years following
- 70 the initial full inventory;
- 71 (d) Develop policies to aid in the implementation of
- 72 the inventory information and reports;
- 73 (e) Submit an annual report to the Legislature on the
- 74 institute's funding, expenditures, accomplishments and
- 75 recommendations; and
- 76 (f) Analyze and publish data on the volume, quality,
- 77 size and ownership of forest resources to provide support for new
- 78 and existing forest industries.
- 79 (2) (a) In accomplishing its duties and formulating the
- 80 recommendations required of it, the institute may elicit the
- 81 support of and participation by any commercial, industrial,
- 82 governmental, environmental, minority and public interest
- 83 organizations or associations, or individual members thereof, and
- 84 any federal, state and local agencies and political subdivisions
- 85 as may be necessary or appropriate in the furtherance of the
- 86 activities of the institute.
- 87 (b) The institute may utilize the services, facilities
- 88 and personnel of all departments, agencies, offices and
- 89 institutions of the state and all such entities are authorized to
- 90 assist the institute and to provide such support.
- 91 <u>SECTION 4.</u> The Executive Directors of the Mississippi
- 92 Institute for Forest Inventory, the Mississippi Forestry
- 93 Commission, the Mississippi Development Authority, the MSU Forest
- 94 and Wildlife Research Center, and the Cooperative Extension
- 95 Service shall establish a procedure and guidelines for the
- 96 coordination of outreach and education programs. It shall be the
- 97 duty of each agency to cooperate and to promote a coordinated
- 98 outreach and education program to increase the utilization of
- 99 private nonindustrial forest landowner forest resources and
- 100 increase profitability for such resources.

- 101 **SECTION 5.** This act shall stand repealed on July 1, 2007.
- 102 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 103 and after July 1, 2002.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO ENACT THE MISSISSIPPI FORESTRY INVENTORY AND
STRATEGIC PLANNING ACT OF 2002; TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI
INSTITUTE FOR FOREST INVENTORY; TO SPECIFY ITS POWERS AND DUTIES;
TO ESTABLISH A BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE INSTITUTE; TO PROVIDE
FOR THE REPEAL OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
