REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3127: Appropriation; Gaming Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State				
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of				
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Gaming Commission, for

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special				
13	funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi				
14	Gaming Commission which are collected by or otherwise become				
15	available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the				
16	Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending				
17	June 30, 2003\$ 5,776,409.00.				
18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
19	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below				
20	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of				
21	expenditure:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 47 48 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 49 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 50 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 51 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 52 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 53 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 54 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 55 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 56 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 57 58 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 59 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 60 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 61 62 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in

accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 63 64 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 65 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 66 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 67 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 68 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 69 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 70 the requirements of this provision are met. 71

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 79 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be 80 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a 81 nonprofit organization.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 82 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 83 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 85 86 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 87 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 88 89 and after July 1, 2002.
