REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3151: Appropriation; Animal Health Board.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Board of Animal Health
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
10	June 30, 2003\$ 1,224,059.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
13	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
14	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Board
15	of Animal Health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and
16	ending June 30, 2003\$ 366,510.00.
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
18	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
19	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
20	expenditure:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 46 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 47 48 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 49 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 50 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 51 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 52 53 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 54 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 55 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 56 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 57 58 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 59 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 60 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 61 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 62

calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 63 64 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 65 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 66 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 67 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 68 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 69 the requirements of this provision are met. 70

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 77 Executive Director of the Mississippi Board of Animal Health may 78 79 authorize increases in other objects of expenditure in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 80 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 81 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 82 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be 83 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 84 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits." 85

86 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 87 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 88 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 89 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 90 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 91 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 92 and after July 1, 2002. 93
