REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the
following entitled BILL:
S. B. No. 3152: Appropriation; Veterinary Diagnostic Lab. Bd.
We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 4 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 5 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 6 defraying the expenses of the Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory 7 Board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending 8 9 June 30, 2003.....\$ 1,117,741.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 10 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 11 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available 12 13 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory Board, for the fiscal year beginning 14 July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... \$ 15 641,259.00. 16 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: 17 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 18 Full Time 25 19 Permanent: 20 Part Time 0 21 Time-Limited: Full Time 0 Part Time 22 0 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 23 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 24

equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the

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26 Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00),27 whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 28 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 29 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 30 31 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 32 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 33 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 34 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 35 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 36 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 37 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 38 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 39 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 40 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 41 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 42 43 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 44 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 45 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 46 47 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 48 49 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 50 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 51 52 the requirements of this provision are met.

53 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 54 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

55 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

59 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature, 60 contingent upon passage of Senate Bill No. 2873, 2002 Regular 61 Session, that all funds, property and other assets, including all current positions of the Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory Board,
shall be transferred to the Board of Trustees of State
Institutions of Higher Learning for the College of Veterinary
Medicine at Mississippi State University on July 1, 2002.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 66 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 67 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 68 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 69 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 70 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 71 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 72 and after July 1, 2002. 73
