 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of

- SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 87 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury
- 88 to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this
- 89 act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the
- 90 State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions
- 91 signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner

- 93 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 94 and after July 1, 2002, except for Section 4 which shall take
- 95 effect and be in force from and after its passage.
