We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry 8 9 Experiment Station for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and 10 ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 17,294,226.00. SECTION 2.
