84	SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of	
85	Section 2, Two Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars	
86	(\$2,300,000.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund	
87	created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972.	
88	SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by	
89	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the	
90	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon	
91	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal	
92	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the	
93	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.	
94	SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from	
95	and after July 1, 2002.
