REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3166: Appropriation; Veterans Affairs Bd.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs
Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
June 30, 2003.....\$ 2,429,586.00.

SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... \$ 22,332,671.00.

SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Health Care Expendable Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Veterans' Affairs Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 700,000.00.
SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of

24 Sections 1, 2 and 3, not more than the amounts set forth below 25 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 26 expenditure:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

52 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 53 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 54 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 55 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 56 57 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 58 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 59 60 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 61

January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 62 63 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 64 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 65 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 66 67 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 68 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 69 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 70 71 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 72 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 73 74 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 75 the requirements of this provision are met. 76

77 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 78 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

83 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 84 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds in 85 the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

(\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to 86 indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the non-veteran 87 88 surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the surviving spouse was a resident of a state veterans home at the time of the 89 veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's death, meets 90 the indigent/low-income criteria established by the State Veterans 91 Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is the intention 92 93 of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to use of indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for any such 94 period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a current 95 surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section and its 96 provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance 97

98 Act of 1997."

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 99 Executive Director of the Veterans Affairs Board may authorize 100 101 increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the appropriated amount of each major 102 103 object of expenditure, provided that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by the corresponding dollar amount. 104 However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major 105 object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits." 106

SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, One Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-nine Dollars (\$121,289.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 111 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 112 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Veterans Affairs 113 Board for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of State 114 115 General Funds authorized in Senate Bill No. 3126, 2001 Regular Session, for the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997" to be used 116 117 for the purpose of hiring nursing staff at the four state veterans' homes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and 118 119 ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 120,000.00.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2002.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 123 124 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 125 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 126 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 127 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 128 129 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002. 130
