We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- S. B. No. 3173: Appropriation; Veterinary Exam. Bd.
 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 3 **SECTION 1**. That the following sum, or so much thereof as may
- 4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 5 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
- 6 Veterinary Examiners for the purpose of defraying the expenses
- 7 incurred by said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002,
- 8 and ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 103,440.00.
- 9 **SECTION 2.** Any transfers or escalations shall be made in
- 10 accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established
- 11 by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 13 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 14 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 15 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 16 **SECTION 3**. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 17 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 18 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 19 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 20 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 21 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 22 **SECTION 4**. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2002.
