 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Workers' Compensation
8	Commission, for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred by
9	said commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and
10	ending June 30, 2003\$ 5,250,450.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
13	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

- 73 **SECTION 4.** With the funds provided herein, it is the intent
- 74 of the Legislature that the Workers' Compensation Commission may
- 75 transfer a sum or sums not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 76 (\$200,000.00) from the Administrative Expense Fund to the Second
- 77 Injury Fund.
- 78 **SECTION 5.** With the funds provided herein, it is the intent
- 79 of the Legislature that the Workers' Compensation Commission may
- 80 transfer a sum or sums not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand
- 81 Dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Administrative Expense Fund to the
- 82 Insurance Integrity Enforcement Bureau within the Office of the
- 83 Attorney General.
- SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 85 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 86 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 87 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 88 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 89 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 90 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 91 and after July 1, 2002.
